Pre-Business requirement: These 34 hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.50 (including transfer), an overall GPA of 2.5 (including transfer), and a grade of "C" or better in each course before a student is allowed to take upper-division business courses. The pre-business GPA is not used to meet any UA requirements such as academic standing, scholarships, or graduation. *Students intending to pursue a major or minor in accounting or finance must complete ACCT 2023.

On-campus students may take up to 35% online and self-paced online courses for degree credit. Only 2 courses (8 hours) of online may be taken in the first 30 hours. Thereafter, 12 hours of online classes are allowed per academic year. Transfer students may not exceed 35% of online and self-paced online courses for their total remaining hours after transfer work is posted.
