ACCT 3753, Intermediate Accounting II (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723 with a grade of “C” or better)

ACCT 3843, Fundamentals of Taxation (Prerequisite: ACCT 2013 with a grade of “B” or better)

ACCT 310V, Accounting Internship (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723)

ACCT 4003H, Honors Accounting Colloquium (Prerequisite: Senior Standing and ACCT 3723 with a grade of “C” or better)

ACCT 410V, Special Topics in Accounting (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723 with a grade of “C” or better)

ACCT 4203, Fundamentals of Taxation II (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723 and ACCT 3843 with a grade of C or better.)

Junior/Senior Business Electives (12 hours)

Selection of electives should be made in consultation with academic advisers. Students planning on taking professional examinations should ascertain course requirements by examining authorities. Successful completion of a Master of Accountancy Degree from the University of Arkansas will qualify a student to take the CPA examination in Arkansas. B.S.B.A. graduates would need additional accounting hours and other courses amounting to a total of 150 semester hours to sit for the CPA exam in Arkansas.

The following courses are highly recommended to satisfy the junior/senior business elective requirement: ACCT 310V, ACCT 410V, ACCT 4003H, FINN 3013, FINN 3103, FINN 3703, ISYS 4213 or any 3-hour Walton College Study Abroad Course. No more than six hours of accounting may be in the major.
