The pre-business GPA is not used to meet any UA requirements such as academic standing, scholarships, or graduation. *Students intending to pursue a major or minor in accounting or finance must complete ACCT 2023.			
On-campus students may take up to 35% online and self-paced online courses for degree credit. Only 2 courses (8 hours) of online may be taken in the first 30 hours. Thereafter, 12 hours of online classes are allowed per academic year. Transfer students may not exceed 35% of online and self-paced online courses for their total remaining hours after transfer work is posted.

Accounting Course Prerequisites

ACCT 3533, Accounting Technology (Prerequisite: ACCT 2013 with a grade of "B")
ACCT 3723, Intermediate Accounting I (Prerequisite: ACCT 2013 with a grade of "B" or better; Corequisite: WCOB 2043 or FINN 3043)
ACCT 3753, Intermediate Accounting II (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723 with a grade of "C" or better)
ACCT 3843, Fundamentals of Taxation (Prerequisite: ACCT 2013 with a grade of "B" or better)
ACCT 4203, Fundamentals of Taxation II (Prerequisite: ACCT 3723 and ACCT 3843 with a grade of C or better)
ACCT 4703, Governmental/Nonprofit Accounting (Prerequisite: ACCT 2013 and ACCT 2023 each with a grade of C or better)

Junior/Senior Business Electives (12 hours)

Selection of electives should be made in consultation with academic advisors.

The following courses are highly recommended to satisfy the junior/senior business elective requirement if not used toward the major: ACCT 310V, ACCT 310VH, ACCT 3543, ACCT 410V, ACCT 4003H, FINN 3013, FINN 3103, ACCT 4123H, ISYS 4213 or any 3-hour Walton College Study Abroad Course. Students in the online program are encouraged to complete ACCT 310V, FINN 3013, ISYS 4213, or any 3-hour Walton College Study Abroad Course.

Maximum of 30 hours of ACCT courses in department (core, major, elective). More than 30 hours allowed if the extra courses are part of interdisciplinary minor or collateral track.

Accounting Students are encouraged to utilize ACCT 310V in the Spring of Year 4 for Internship Credit as a business elective (in combination with compressed sections of ACCT 3543 and ACCT 4673). To do so requires the student to defer 3 credit hours of General Education electives to an alternative Fall, Spring, or Summer semester. This also strengthens the ability of the student to transition into the Master of Accounting Program.
