ENTERPRISE SYSTEMS EXPANSION

The Walton Enterprise Systems program is continually expanding its partnerships, offerings, and reach around the world and supporting more faculty and researchers and students with our growing collaborations. The most recent new collaborations and expansions include:

- Dillard's Live – an expansion of the Dillard's dataset that includes weekly data updates,
- New SAS tools to meet new challenges of big and complex datasets: SAS Viya 3.5 and the new SAS EG & SAS EM versions,
- Accounting Textbook analytics support expanding to universities in China.

IBM & Z15

The University of Arkansas serves as an IBM hub for universities that are teaching mainframe and open-source Linux courses. The Sam M. Walton College of Business has been enhancing students' class experiences through the use of courseware and access to hardware and software provided by IBM and the Academic Initiative.

IBM has been a longtime partner of the Information Systems (ISYS) Department and the Walton College of Business. In 2017, IBM gifted the Enterprise Systems group with their latest Z13 Mainframe in order to enhance and expand the curriculum offered by the ISYS Department. This gift was intended for both "teaching and non-commercial research".

Enterprise Systems is pleased to announce that IBM is providing Enterprise Systems with Z15 hardware at no cost and gifting software for academic and classroom use in the Walton College. This gift's primary purpose is the enhancement of our Blockchain curriculum. These enhancements will allow the Blockchain Center of Excellence faculty to enhance our student's skills in:

- 1) spinning up blockchain nodes for quick development,
- 2) hosting persistent public blockchain nodes,
- 3) applying enterprise-level analytic tools,
- 4) providing Hyperledger Fabric instruction, along with many additional skillset enhancements.

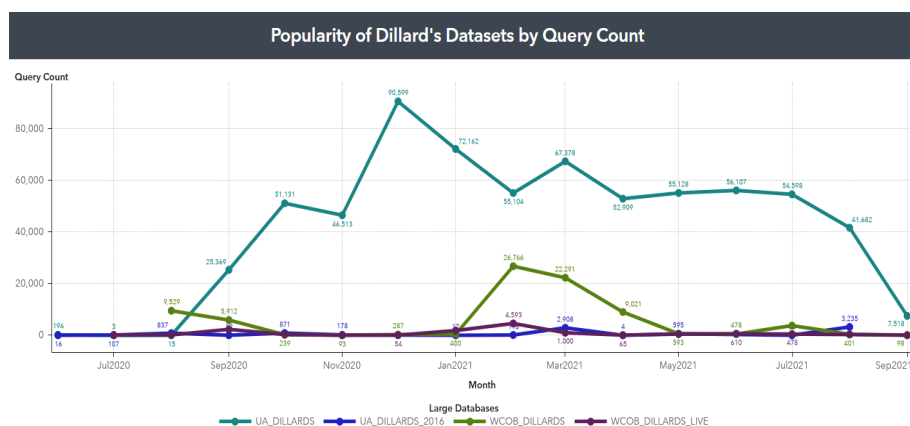
We continue to look forward to IBM's support of our programs and want to recognize their contribution to our programs.

HIGHLIGHT: DILLARD'S LIVE

Dillard's Inc. has had an ongoing collaboration with Walton College Enterprise Systems. This collaboration has resulted in several gifted datasets, updates, and finally a weekly updated gift for advancing the skillsets of both our students and faculty.

The initial retail sales information, UA_DILLARDS_2016 was provided by Dillard's Inc. to the Walton College of Business, consists of five tables with more than 128 million rows populated and ready for use. Dillard's updated this dataset in 2018 (WCOB_DILLARDS) which included the same five tables and consisted of 75 million customers. The newest dataset provided in 2019 includes weekly updates to WCOB_DILLARDS_LIVE.

The Dillard's gifted datasets are based on real operational data; real retail sales information gathered from store sales transactions. This data provides a unique opportunity to expose students to real data. The latest collaboration with the Dillard's Live dataset allows faculty and students to create inferences on prior data in order to test model efficacy with the next week's update. In addition to their gift, Dillard's participates in mentoring student groups at both the graduate and undergraduate level. These student groups work directly with the Dillard's Live dataset.



ACCOUNTING SPOTLIGHT

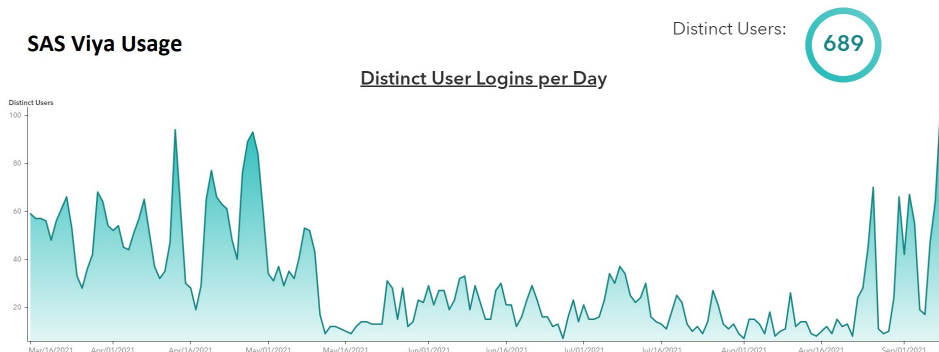
Walton Enterprise Systems has supported accounting classes on our Microsoft SQL platform for many years now. With the growing success of *Data Analytics for Accounting* (Richardson, Terrell, & Teeter), a textbook merging both analytics and accounting fields, we are seeing numerous accounting courses using our SQL platform to access datasets from this text and a steady increase each year in the number of both classes and students using this textbook since its release in 2018 (2nd edition in 2020). In fact, users have expanded into China at Wuhan Institute of Technology. We are happy to have both students and faculty from all over the world on our platform in support of accounting and analytics.

The ongoing relationship between Walton Enterprise Systems and Data Analytics for Accounting has shown how related these fields are to one another and how analytics can be leveraged to gain insights in the accounting world. We look forward to expanding our platform and continuing to offer our world-class datasets.

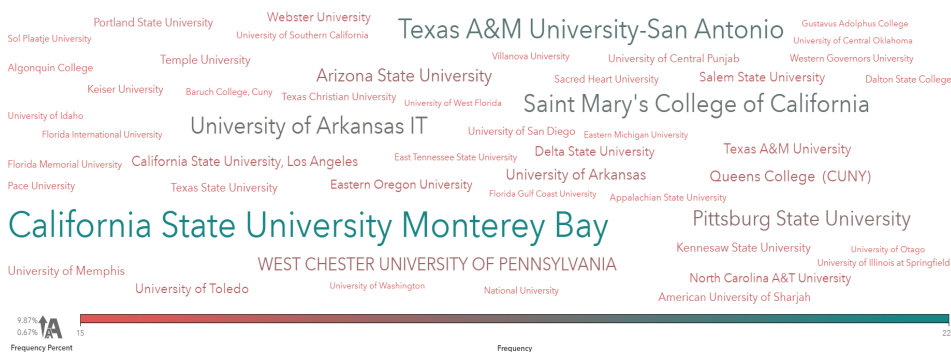


SAS & TERADATA SPOTLIGHT
