

In the second quarter, 266 residential building permits were issued, an increase from the 185 issued in the first quarter but a decrease from the 416 permits issued in the same period last year.

The average sale price of a home decreased by 11.6 percent in Benton County, from \$181,215 to \$160,114, and by 10 percent in Washington County, from \$184,158 to \$165,824.
