


# **Labor Force, Year Over Year Percent Change**








# **Arkansas Non-Farm Employment Forecast**






# **Change in Arkansas Employment by Sector 2018-2019**






# **Change in Arkansas Employment by Sector 2009-2019**





# Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway MSA Non-Farm Employment




# Change in Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway MSA Employment by Sector, 2018-2019






# Change in Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway MSA Employment by Sector, 2009-2019








# **Northwest Arkansas Employment Forecast**




