




### **Real U.S. Gross Domestic Product Growth Rate**






## Quarterly Change in Business Investment









## **Quarterly Change in Durable Goods**

Non-annualized, seasonally and inflation adjusted. Shaded areas denote recessions.
















**Finding One:** While aggregate spending of the employed was down by 10 percent during the initial months of the pandemic, the spending of unemployment benefit recipients increased 10 percent, a pattern which is likely explained by the \$600 federal weekly benefit supplement.

### Spending Falls at Start of Unemployment and Rises when Benefit Payments Begin





The treatment group, shown in orange, receives benefits beginning in April. The control group, shown in blue, is employed workers. 




How comfortable would you feel attending the following types of indoor cultural facilities today, assuming they were open and following social distancing guidelines and other health safety procedures?


## Northwest Arkansas Available Square Footage






### **R&D Expenditures 2017-2018**





## Change in Northwest Arkansas MSA Employment by Sector, August 2019 - August 2020






### **Unemployment Rate, Annual Average**



### **Unemployment Rates, Not Seasonally Adjusted**




### **Labor Force, Year Over Year Percent Change**




### Median Cost of Homeownership as Percent of Income




## Benton and Washington County Average Price of Houses Sold




# Selected Cities in Benton County Average Price of Houses Sold






# Selected Cities in Benton County Empty Lots in Active Subdivisions






## Average Price of New Houses Sold



# Bentonville, Fayetteville, Rogers, Springdale Average Square Feet of New Houses Sold




