Fayetteville Shale Play Impact Revised Upward

Job creation and investment related to the Fayetteville Shale Play have topped 2008 predictions of \$17.9 billion in economic activity between 2008 and 2012.

A study released Tuesday (June 5) by the [Center for Business and Economic Research \(http://cber.uark.edu/\)](http://cber.uark.edu/) in the Sam M. Walton College of Business at the University of Arkansas and sponsored by the Arkansas State Chamber of Commerce, updated the economic impact figures generated by the activities of the natural gas industry concentrated in the north central region of Arkansas.
