Other sessions are in El Dorado, Bentonville, West Memphis/Jonesboro, and Central Arkansas and will cover the economies in those geographic areas.

Following graduation, Mervin began working for the Center for Business & Economic Research. In 2011, he earned a master's degree in public administration with an emphasis in public policy.
